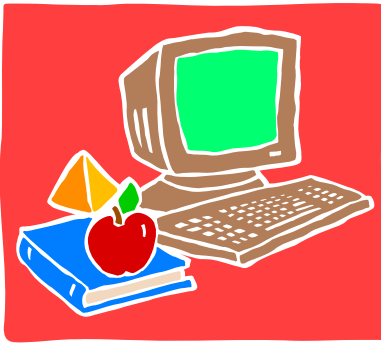

I would like to remind parents of several tips for keeping children safe during arrival and dismissal times. Please remember that no cars are to be in the inner driveway (closest to the building) between 8:45 and 9:20 or 3:30 to 4:05. Nor should cars be parked in the outer driveway during those times. If you wish to bring your children into the building or to pick them up at dismissal, please park in one of the two lots or up the hill on Crestwick Road. The outer driveway is used for drop-off only during our arrival time. The inner driveway is used for car riders pick-up during dismissal time. These are moving car pool lines and drivers should stay in their cars. Students should depart and enter from the right sides of the car next to the curb. Please do not ask students to pass between cars to get to your car. This is very unsafe. Please remember that we do not have adult supervision for students prior to 9:05 and after 4:05.



The connection between home and school is an important one, and good communication is the key. If you have any questions about your child's progress, your first contact should be with his/her teacher. Many of you have discovered that sending teachers an email is an efficient way to update them or to ask a quick question. Let me remind you, however, that teachers are not always able to check their emails during the school day.

Federal law requires us to notify parents and/or legal guardians, and all staff of the availability of our asbestos management plan during the month of September.
