The Maryland State Assessment (MSA) will begin on Monday, March 3, 2014 and will run for 8 consecutive school days through Wednesday, March, 11, 2014. The Maryland School Assessment (MSA) is a test of reading, math, and science achievement. This test provides educators,

parents, and the public with valuable information about student, school, school system, and state performance. The reading and mathematics tests are administered to students in grades 3 through 8. The science test is administered in April to grades 5 and 8. We encourage you to get your children to school on time, with a good night's sleep, and a healthy breakfast so that they can perform to the best of their ability. MSA grades remain a permanent part of your child's educational record, and they need to be encouraged to do their BEST.



ATTENDANCE - Congratulations students and parents! Cromwell's student attendance for the second quarter was 96.4%. Zone Two's student attendance for the second quarter was 95.6% and Baltimore County's student attendance for the second quarter was 93.9%. I wanted to take this opportunity to remind parents who drop off and pick up children how important it is that you follow the arrival and dismissal procedures. If you are using the carpool line in the morning, please remember it is a moving line. We ask that you only use the first four spaces to drop off your children. We have had several parents express concern that some parents are letting their child(ren) out of the car on the outside of the car pool lane which causes them to cross in front of traffic. **Do not have children get out of**

your car unless you are in one of the four drop off spaces. This is a serious safety concern. Please have your children ready to exit the car quickly and please do not get out of the car for any reason in the driveway. This is for the safety of children and to keep our line moving so that cars are not backed up on Providence Road waiting to get into our driveway. Lately we have had many students arriving prior to 9:05. Please remember that we do not have adult supervision before that time, and although our boys and girls are generally very well behaved, conflicts can arise. We ask your cooperation in adhering to our arrival time and not dropping off students early. Students may enter the building at 9:05 a.m. In the afternoon, our carpool line is working very well. Please remember that no one is to park in the outer driveway and then cross the inner driveway to pick up children from the school. This is a safety hazard for you and for your children. Parked cars should be in the parking lots or the street only. Thank you for your cooperation.
